Question: How do I get documentation that shows I'm enrolled this semester?

Answer: You'll want to ask your supervisor what kind of document he needs. A print out of your current schedule or a copy of your unofficial transcripts may be sufficient.

If you need an official document, the National Student Clearinghouse is the University of New Mexico's authorized agent for providing enrollment and degree verification. If an employer or background screening firm requests this information, refer them to the National Student Clearinghouse at (703) 742-4200 or <http://www.studentclearinghouse.org>

You may also print an Enrollment Certification from LoboWeb by following these simple instructions:

1. Go to my.unm.edu
2. Click on the "Student Life" tab at the top of the screen
3. Click on the "Lobo Web" icon
4. Select "Registration and Records"
5. Under "Student Schedule" select "ENROLLMENT CERTIFICATION"
6. Follow the instructions on this page.
