Question: How can I improve my academic standing?

**Answer:** UNM allows you to do grade replacement for up to 12 hours of coursework by completing a simple form at the Records Office. Retake the course in which you did poorly and when the grade posts at the end of the semester, fill out the form at Records. Please note that grade replacement can only be done one time per class and it must be done before your degree is awarded. The original grade will still appear on your transcript, but with an "E" next to it, showing that it's excluded from the GPA calculation.
