1. FOR THE SIXTH CONSECUTIVE YEAR, UNM has been named in the annual report on America's 100 Best College Buys® designating the University as one of America's best college educations for the cost. Institutional Research and Evaluation, Inc. compiled the list from a survey of 1,488 accredited U.S. colleges and universities offering four-year undergraduate degree programs. UNM ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR Natasha Kolchevska has been awarded a \$122,772 grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities to conduct a national institute exploring the music and performance of Tchaikovsky's opera, "Eugene Onegin," and its relation to Russian culture.
