Searched Rio la Santa near mouth of Duran creek.

8:00 - 9:30 AMST. A. 37 W 41 8:00, A 47 W 42 9:30 AMST.

Weather clear with scattered clouds, cloudy at end.
Heavy rain remainder of day (and probably night)

This section has a considerable number of new pools. Some are new horse dams, mentioned earlier this month and others are ^{two} rock dams (created by some fisherman?). These latter were productive of fish. Accidentally or otherwise a flat stone was left in the deeper part of the pool in such a way that it gave the fish shelter. Four good sized (about legal size) were taken from beneath.

Young fish ~~did~~ were not in evidence in the pools. Weather conditions were such that observations were difficult.
