1. IN A HISTORIC AND UNPRECEDENTED interview, Russian President Vladimir Putin will take questions directly from the American people during a special broadcast from KUNM Radio 89.9 and National Public Radio News Thursday, Nov. 15, from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m. The live call-in program will be moderated by Robert Siegel, host of "All Things Considered." This is the only interview President Putin has granted during his current visit to the United States.

2. THE UNM FOUNDATION/DEVELOPMENT office has been ranked in The Chronicle of Philanthropy's annual ranking of the top 400 nonprofit organizations. UNM entered the list at No. 393, the first time it has earned recognition in the publication. The Philanthropy 400 survey ranks 400 of the nation's largest nonprofit organizations by how much money they raise from private sources.
