Searched Rio la Santa near the mouth of Polcarpio creek from 3:30 - 4:45 PM S.T. Six foot seine. Air 70 Water 50°F at 3:30 P.M. - About maximum for day. Weather. Cloudy. Raining at the end of seining and that night. The forest ranger reports nearly 2 inches of rain at Kenasco.

Young of year still abundant in beaver pools and other quiet places.

The big beaver dam just below Polcarpio creek did not seem to have as many fish in as last time. The dam level has been raised a little.

I have the impression that fish were more common in the small pockets off riffles (undercut banks and small pools) than has been the case.
