Falls of the Rio Puella. 1215-1240

The trout, seemingly both rainbows and cut-throats were jumping in good numbers. Only one was seen to jump about $\frac{1}{2}$ the way across when most jumped in previous years. Today most were jumping on the right side, right next to the bank. Commonly they misjudged the direction of the falls and hit the rock side head on. Size 6-13 inches. A 65 W 55 1240

Rio la Santa

Trout are not spawning. Examined the entire main stream between Mellano and Policarpis Creeks, the lower $\frac{1}{4}$ mile of each of these streams and the spring run below Policarpis.

Rio la Santa is moderately turbid, the remaining streams are clear.

Seined from 1430 to 1600 and angled from 1700-1800 using worms. Tried to get adults to determine condition of gonads. No ad females taken. One adult male which was ripe.
