Stream with less ice than last month. Bank to bank ice cover present only where protected by deep drifts and shade. Beaver pools largely open including one near cabin. Ice still covered the area where I dug hole last month. No hole was dug as the ice looked too rotten to support my weight. Fish were not seen in the beaver pools but visibility was very poor because of clouds. The stream is clear although the weather of days past has caused a slight rise. The Rio Grande was seen to be turbid in the canyon on the way to Tres Ritos.

Snow is 2-4 plus feet deep in the Rio la Junta canyon bottom. The south facing slope is largely free of snow, the north-facing slope heavily covered with snow. Adult stoneflies were present on the snow during the afternoon.

The fish were kept packed in snow from time of capture until they were measured the next forenoon between 800 and 1200. They were limp but firm - "nice and fresh" -
