There has just appeared from the University of New Mexico Press (Bulletin 300, January 15, 1937), Excavation of the Riana Ruin and Chama Valley Survey, by Frank C. Hibben, which is Volume 2, Number 1, of the Anthropological Series (formerly Archaeological Series), price 50 cents. This bulletin of 60 pages, with 8 figures and 13 plates, provides the best guide, to date, to the ruins of the Chama area. It also incorporates the first published account of a Wiyo ruin excavation in the Chama. Mr. W. S. Stallings, Jr., of the Laboratory of Anthropology has contributed a section on the Riana tree ring material, with a conclusion that the pueblo was fired shortly after 1348.
