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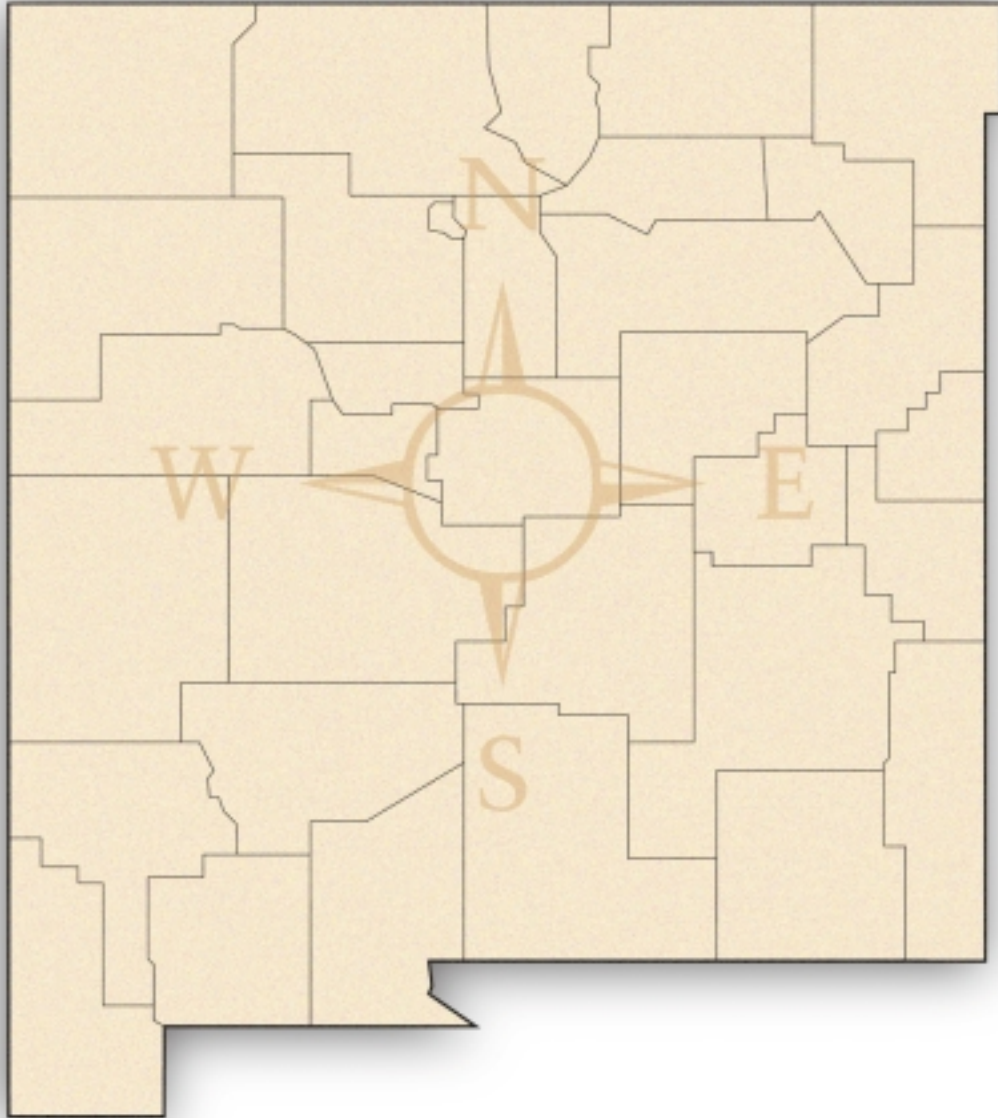

- 576 MD recipients of the UNM School of Medicine (UNM SOM) have completed their residency training, are licensed to practice in New Mexico, and have a New Mexico address. This represents 28% of the total number of MD recipients from UNM SOM (N=2,050).
- 1,222 physicians who received their MD and/or completed their residencies at the UNM School of Medicine are licensed to practice in New Mexico. This represents 24% of the School's total number of MD recipients and former residents (N=5,056).
- Of the 1,222 MD recipients and former residents licensed to practice in New Mexico, 591 (or 48%) are in primary care specialties.
- Over the past 6 years, the number of UNM-trained physicians practicing in New Mexico has grown from 819 to 1,222, a 49% increase.
- Of the 3,509 physicians licensed to practice and in New Mexico**, 35% are MD recipients and/or former residents of the UNM School of Medicine.
- MD recipients and former residents of the UNM School of Medicine are located in 30 of New Mexico's 33 counties.
- 631 MD recipients and former residents licensed to practice in New Mexico are trained in specialties other than primary care. Two hundred sixty-six of them are represented in four specialties, anesthesiology, general surgery, emergency medicine and psychiatry, and are practicing in 19 of New Mexico's 33 counties (see page 5 in this report).

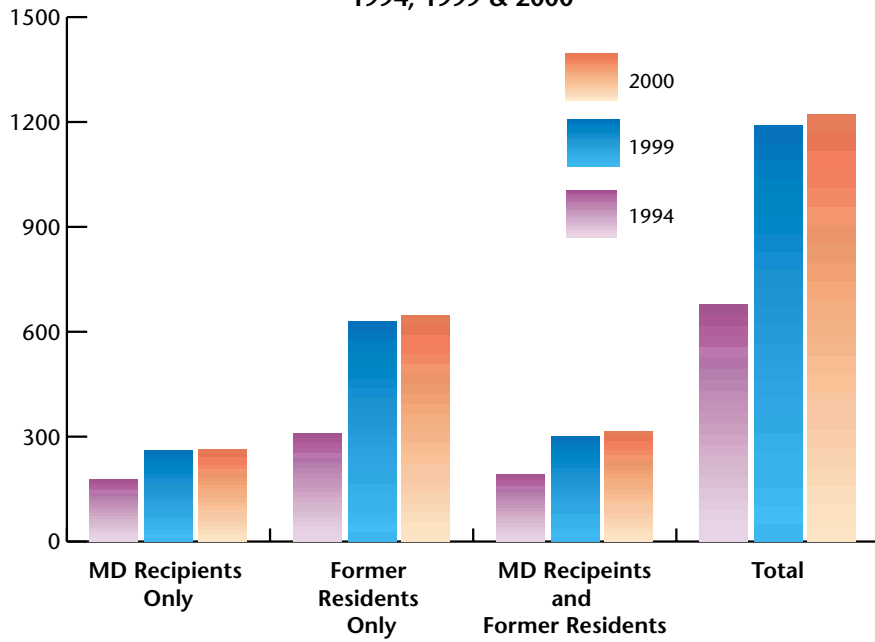

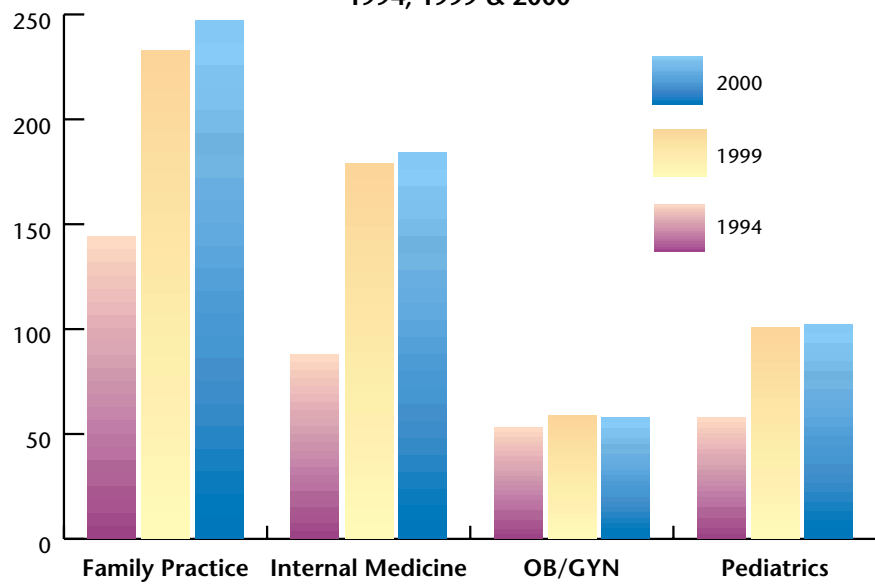

Effective December, 2000

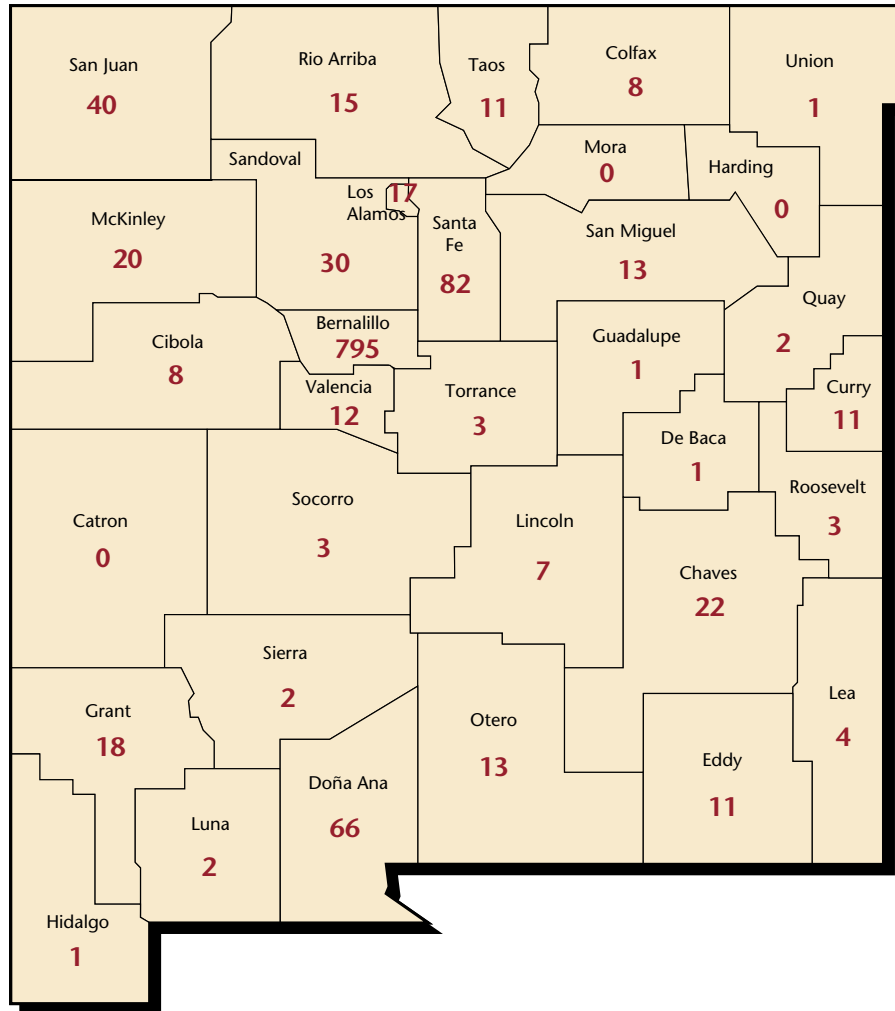
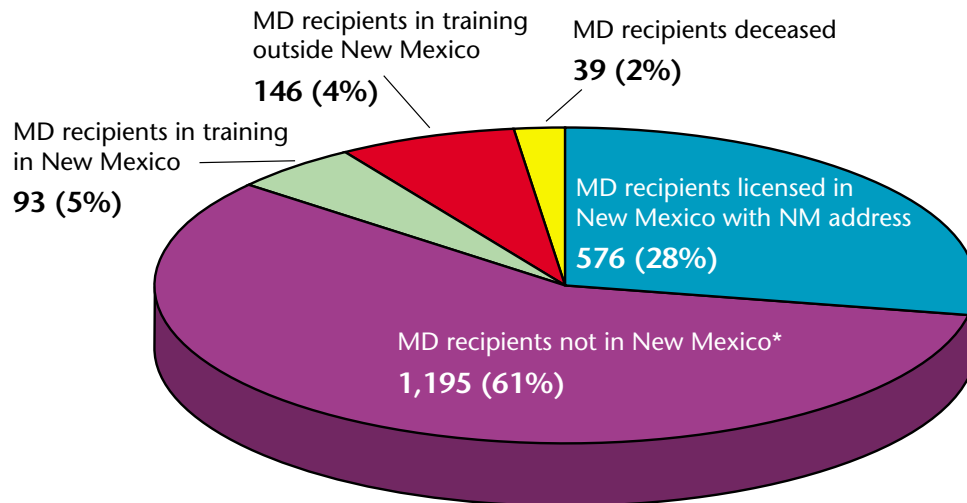


FIGURE 4: DISTRIBUTION OF MD RECIPIENTS

LOCATION REPORT 2001: THE APPROACH AND METHODS

Our interest in this report is to provide the best available evidence about UNM School of Medicine MD recipients and former residents who were in New Mexico as of December 31, 2000. It is important to note that any recent moves or change in location by these individuals may not be reflected in our data.

A number of sources were used in the compilation of this report. The initial lists of names and social security numbers of University of New Mexico School of Medicine MD recipients (1968-2000) and former residents (1955 to 2000) were obtained from two sources: the University of New Mexico School of Medicine's Office of Student Affairs and Office of Graduate Medical Education (GME), respectively.

Several additional sources were used to confirm both names and New Mexico address/location. These included the *New Mexico Board of Medical Examiners' 2001 Official List*, the *Yearbook and Directory of Osteopathic Physicians 2000/2001* and a dataset of 1,200 UNM School of Medicine graduates maintained by the Office of Program Evaluation, Education and Research at UNM SOM.

We confirmed the specialty and location of 1,160 physicians in New Mexico by telephone or mail between October 2000 and May 2001. We were unable to reach 62 of 1,222 physicians included in our total. The basis for confirming individuals for this report was twofold:

- 1) individual was included in Location Report, 2000, or
- 2) State of New Mexico Board of Medical Examiners' 2001 Official List included:
 - information about physicians returning to New Mexico, or
 - information about physicians who completed residency training in past year, were licensed to practice and were practicing in New Mexico.

We developed several strategies to obtain more information about current location for those individuals included in the Location Report, 2000 for whom address and telephone numbers were no longer accurate. We sought and received assistance from ten UNM School of Medicine residency coordinators in locating approximately 40 former residents for whom we had no address or telephone number. We used the 2001 edition of *Directory of Physicians in the United States* published by the AMA to obtain addresses for the other individuals in our database with no current telephone number.

A list of UNM SOM MD recipients and former residents who were believed to be deceased was confirmed through three sources—the UNM SOM Office of Student Affairs, the Alumni Office and the Social Security Death Index. For those individuals whose whereabouts remain unknown or unconfirmed, further investigation will follow.

In addition to self-report, the *New Mexico Board of Medical Examiners' 2001 Official List* and the *Yearbook and Directory of Osteopathic Physicians 2000/2001* became the gold standard for inclusion in this report. These sources, which are based on self-reported license applications, provided information about the current license status and address of both UNM SOM MD recipients and former residents. These data sources do not always distinguish between home and work address. A few individuals in these rosters may work and live in different counties. However, they are reported only once in our data. Individuals who live in New Mexico but are not licensed are reported in our data in the column "Not in New Mexico" which represents those with no known NM license and/or no known NM address.
