Alpha Chapter of Mu Alpha Nu, Professional and Honorary Anthropological Fraternity, was organized at the University of Southern California in 1934, Beta Chapter, at the University of New Mexico, was organized the following year, and in 1936 Gamma Chapter followed at the University of Arizona. At Flagstaff, Arizona, in 1936, representatives of the three chapters met and organized Mu Alpha Nu as a National Fraternity. Mr. Frank Hibben was elected Grand President, Mr. Robert Lister, General Secretary, and Miss Elizabeth Murphy, General Treasurer (term of office: Spring, 1936 - Spring, 1938). Dr. Clark Wissler and Dr. F.W. Hodge were elected Honorary Vice-Presidents. The purpose of Mu Alpha Nu is "to stimulate and further the interest and study of Anthropology, and related fields; to recognize work of outstanding merit and discourage unscientific and destructive work." Student membership is based on a major or minor in the field of Anthropology, advancement, and high scholastic standing. Professional membership is based upon the completion of work of outstanding merit in Anthropology or the related sciences. There are prospects of the addition of additional chapters to Mu Alpha Nu.

Beta Chapter of Mu Alpha Nu, at the University of New Mexico, seeks in addition to the aims of the National Fraternity to stimulate publication of researches; the development of a comprehensive anthropological library; and eventually plans to establish a scholarship for deserving anthropology students under the necessity of earning their own living. Monthly meetings are held, at which lectures are given on the various phases of Anthropology, and open-forum discussion of current Anthropological problems is encouraged. Field trips are planned and held at frequent intervals. Miss Bertha Dutton is President of Beta Chapter; Mr. Bob Lister, Vice-President; Miss Anne Espe, Secretary; Mr. Robert Young, Treasurer; and Mr. J. Charles Kelley, Editor. (term of office: April, 1936 - April, 1937) Mu Alpha Nu, Beta Chapter, encourages and supervises student contributions to the periodic publication, El Palacio. Dr. Donald D. Brand acts as Faculty Sponsor for Beta Chapter.
