
MacArthur 'Genius' Grant

Parable of the Sower

Through the diary entries of Lauren Oya Olameda, 15, which begin in 2024 set in postapocalyptic Los Angeles County she begins documenting her discovery of the religion *Earthseed*. The world has been ravaged by global warming, economic collapse, and a drug pandemic, pyro, that has caused mass destruction from the users need to start fires & watch them burn. After she is driven out of her secluded gated community by 'Crazies' she is joined by two other surviving community members and forced to set off North toward Canada in hopes of finding somewhere to begin the first Earthseed community.

Afrofuturism


a cultural movement that explores the intersection of African American culture with science fiction and fantasy

Hyperempathy "sharing" - According to Butler condition is strictly a delusion, not some super power


Originally a calculated leader, manipulative - who orders assassinations on her enemies & puts shock collars on members who try to leave

a fusion of concepts from Heraclitus, Darwin, & Buddha idea of: science fiction as religion

- space colonization

"A sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it. And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away because it lacked moisture. And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprang up with it, and choked it.
