

JEI Minutes: December 5, 2022

Many members were attending the climate survey focus groups, and could not attend this meeting so next month's meeting in January will feature the icebreakers.

 - Any new ideas or possible new members should please be sent to the JEI chair by 1/15/23 in order to be discussed in the January events subcommittee meeting. Possible idea to partner with the Truman clinic. A member (LH) has worked with them before and had the AIDS quilt displayed and the clinic helped with the costs. She also volunteered to help with that.
 - Kate Stuenkel is a faculty member who has participated in panels at UNM before. She is an excellent resource that

we may be able to reach out to for any Transgender trainings/events.

- Climate surveys: The HSC climate survey work is being conducted and after it's anonymized it will be shared throughout the HSC in fall 2023. As the HSLIC surveys continue to be completed, there may be opportunities for the JEI committee to review the results and see where feedback and initiatives may begin to address ideas and/or concerns (especially around hiring and retention).
The survey work is continuing with inclusive language in its design.
