1. THE UNM BOARD of Regents recently approved a 5.4 percent increase in tuition and fees for resident undergraduate and graduate students for FY 2007-2008. This brings the undergraduate tuition and fee total to \$4, 570.80, up from \$4,335.60. Tuition accounts for 3.8 percent of the increase, while 1.6 percent goes to a scheduled fee increase approved by regents in 2005.
