3. ANTHROPOLOGY PROFESSOR Lawrence Straus recently completed the fifth, two-month campaign of National Science Foundation-sponsored excavations in El Miron Cave in northern Spain. Among his 20 student crew were seven UNM graduate and undergraduate students. The excavations concentrated on very rich layers dating back to the early-Magdalenian period, about 14-16,000 years ago.
