THE UNM CAMPUS and surrounding neighborhoods will be subjected to an extremely loud noise associated with a 15-minute, pre-stack test scheduled to occur at the Ford Utilities Center sometime between 2 – 2:30 p.m. today, Thursday, Oct. 19. The pre-stack test, which will measure noise levels in preparation of the forthcoming actual test, consists of releasing steam from the boilers into the atmosphere and is in conjunction with UNM's air quality permits.
