On Oct. 31, Mexico's representative at the GATT Uruguay Round, Jesus Seade Kuri, told reporters that his government had submitted a protest to GATT against Washington's anti-dumping sanctions imposed on Mexican cement and television imports. In August, the US imposed a nearly 60% tariff on Mexican cement imports. Next, Washington has commenced an investigation of claims that the Mexican television assembly industry is unloading TVs in the US market at prices below average production costs.
