The article, "Imagery Rehearsal Therapy for Chronic Nightmares in Sexual Assault Survivors with Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD)," summarizes a study which concluded that treating chronic nightmares with imagery rehearsal therapy reduces the frequency of disturbing dreams, improves sleep quality and decreases PTSD symptoms.
