1. THE UNM FOUNDATION announced that UNM received \$35.3 million in private funds during the 2000-01 fiscal year. The amount constitutes a 12.4 percent increase over fiscal year 1999-2000, and 6.9 percent more than its \$33 million goal.

2. UNM DISTINGUISHED PROFESSOR of Chemical and Nuclear Engineering Jeff Brinker and graduate student Dhaval Doshi are among six winners named in the National Collegiate Inventors Competition. The winning entry, "Optically-Adjustable Nanostructures," is a self-assembly approach to prepare photosensitive porous thin-film nanostructures and developed lithographic procedures.

4. THE UNM GENERAL LIBRARY is upgrading network connectivity in all four main campus branch libraries as part of the first phase of the Information Commons project.
