1. THE UNM HEALTH SCIENCES CENTER (HSC) was awarded a \$750,000 grant to Support the UNM Telehealth Outreach for Unified Community Health. Funding for the program, a joint effort by the UNM HSC and the John A. Burns School of Medicine in Hawaii, was appropriated by the U.S. Department Health and Human Services.
