## **Consumer & Wholesale Price Index, September**

The Banco de Mexico reported Oct. 9 that consumer price inflation during September was 1.4%, the lowest monthly rate since November 1989. The accumulated rate for the first nine months of the year was 21%, and the 12-month rate, 28.6%. The wholesale price index for September increased 3.8%. Excluding petroleum, wholesale prices rose an average 1.7%. (Sources: El Financiero, The Mexico City News, El Nacional, Excelsior, 10/10/90)
