## **Ecuador: Official Results Of May 17 Presidential Election**

On June 10, the Supreme Electoral Council released the official results of the May 17 presidential elections. Of 3,416,916 valid ballots, Sixto Duran Ballen (Republican Unity Party) received 31.88%; Jaime Nebot (Social Christian Party), 25.03%; and, Abdala Bucaram (Ecuadoran Roldosista Party), 21.96%. Eligible voters numbered about 6 million. Ballen and Nebot will compete in a run-off election July 5. On June 24, spokespersons for the Supreme Electoral Court told reporters that 12 experts from the Latin American Center for Electoral Training will monitor the run-off.
