According to the Inter-American Development Bank's annual report titled "Social and Economic Progress in Latin America," of a total \$4.8855 billion in direct foreign investment channeled to the region in 1989, \$2.2422 billion, or 45.9%, went to Mexico. The report was released Oct. 27 in Washington. Direct foreign investment for the 1980-1989 period channeled to Mexico totaled \$17.5571 billion, or 34.9% of the total for the region.
