On Oct. 24, the Banco de Mexico reported that consumer price inflation in the first half of October was 0.9%, compared to 1.0% for the same period last year. Inflation since Jan. 1 totals 21.9%, up from 13.5% last year. (Source: Knight-Ridder Financial, 10/24/90)
