## Access Pediatrics & Access Surgery added to HSLIC's Collection

HSLIC has added Access Pediatrics and Access Surgery to the collection. Both of these resources are provided from McGraw Hill and have a similar format as Access Medicine.

New

A collection of medical e-books, such as Rudolph's Pediatrics, and Clinical Guidelines in Neonatology, board review questions, and drug information.

New

A collection of e-books, such as Zollinger's Atlas of Surgical Operations and Schwartz's Principles of Surgery. Also includes exam/board prep tools such as ABSITE Slayer.

These resources are available at the above links or by going to HSLIC's Database Page and searching for the titles of the databases. Individual ebooks are discoverable in HSLIC's catalog and have unlimited access.

Access Pediatrics covers the entire span of pediatric practice, from neonatology through adolescent medicine. It is updated regularly and optimized for viewing on any device. It provides instant access to information essential for completing evaluation, diagnosis, and case management decisions, as well as for pursuing research or self-assessment and board review -- all in one place. Some of the titles include:

It also offers concise outlines of conditions and disorders most often encountered in medical practice from the [Texas Children's Hospital Handbook](#) – whether used as a high-yield review for studying or for quick reference in a clinical setting. Images and algorithms are also highlighted in the search to help confirm diagnosis and clinical decision making. There are also pediatric board review resources that are designed to prepare residents for their boards by offering questions and answers that mirror the case vignette style on current board exams.

Access Surgery provides a variety of resources to help medical students excel in their surgery clerkship; assist residents in gaining instant access to videos, self-assessment, and leading surgical textbooks that will establish an important foundation for learning; and allows practicing surgeons to

brush up on their medical knowledge when studying for their Maintenance of Certification Exam. Some titles included in Access Surgery are:
