Chilean Exports To Japan, January-may 1992

According to Eduardo Rodriguez Guarachi, Chilean Ambassador to Japan, exports to Japan over the first five months of the year totaled US\$917.4 million, up 10% compared to the same period last year. Japan's major imports from Chile were copper concentrate (US\$189 million); copper cathodes (US\$167 million); frozen Pacific salmon (US\$109.6 million); and, fish meal (US\$47.8 million).
