Chile: Iansa Plans Construction Of New Apple Juice Concentrate Facility

On July 2, spokespersons for Industria Azucarera Nacional (Iansa) said the company plans to invest US\$3 million in construction of a new apple juice concentrate plant in southern Chile. The plant, expected to begin operations in February 1993, will produce 1,500 metric tons of apple juice per year. Iansa currently processes 5,000 metric tons of apple juice at its Curico plant. The new facility will bring Iansa's apple supply requirements to about 14 million MT of apples per year. [Sources: El Diario (Chile), El Mercurio (Chile), 07/03/92]
