On Nov. 10, PEMEX's general manager for the southern region, Rafael Cervantes Sandoval, told reporters that the company is engaged in drilling 51 exploratory wells in Tabasco and Veracruz states. The wells are located in the Papalopan Basin; Veracruz municipalities Cerro Azul, Nanchital, Agua Dulce and Las Chopas; and Tabasco municipalities Comacalco and Ciudad Pemex.
