## **Public Sector Investment Down 17% In 1990**

On Nov. 6, El Financiero reported that despite the federal government's 1990 budget plan for a 14.4% real increase in investment, the figure will be about 17% less in real terms than in 1989. The business newspaper attributed the outcome to annual inflation of about 27%, and a variety of budget adjustments and cutbacks. By sector, the most substantial reductions in real government investment were recorded for communications and transportation (-54.9%) and social welfare projects (-32.4%).
