1	<b>Approval of Minutes</b>	The minutes for September 21, 2010 were approved.	
2	<b>H/R representation at committee meetings</b>	The presence of a representative from Human Resources (HR) at committee meetings was discussed. Motion moved and passed: Presence by HR staff at a committee meeting will be by invitation only. Meeting minutes will be available to HR staff.	HR staff may make written comments and recommendations in response to the minutes. The HR representative arrived at the meeting and she was amenable to this resolution. She excused herself and left.
3	<b>The "UNM Cost Containment/ Revenue Generation:</b>	Recommendation of Strategies for FY12 and Beyond," by the President's Strategic Advisory Team, dated December 10, 2010, was briefly discussed.	Discussion tabled
4	<b>UNM HR Job Analysis Questionnaire (JAQ) webinar</b>	The Committee would like to hold a seminar/webinar about the UNM HR Job Analysis Questionnaire (JAQ) outlining the JAQ procedures. The history of the UNM Pact was presented in relation to JAQ discussion. It was mentioned that some of the HR policies are difficult for staff to find and to understand.	Follow up on committee member assignments. Planning Session to follow.
5	<b>"Know Your Rights"</b>	The Committee proposes to work with the Staff Council Communications Committee to publish a "Know Your Rights" flyer, presentation, and possibly a webpage. The information will highlight basic UNM policies in basic language and include webpage information as well as telephone numbers to the appropriate contacts. All products will also be available in Spanish. All items will be submitted to HR for written comment.	Romeo will see if the Committee has a budget and report at the next meeting. 6	<b>Employee health insurance payments</b>	Employee health insurance payments were discussed. This may save the University money as well as be more equitable to all staff.</p>
