According to recent reports by the Fisheries Secretariat (SEPESCA), Mexico's sustainable shrimp catch has declined by 35% in recent years due to over-exploitation and oceanographic changes impacting on reproductive capacity. SEPESCA statistics contained in an annex to President Carlos Salinas de Gortari's state of the union address indicated that the 1990 catch is expected to reach 80,000 MT, up 5,000 tons compared to 1989.
