 - a. Byron – Community Emergency Response Team – (C-CERT)
 - i. Need volunteers to complete 20hrs of basic training, Friday through Sunday

- b. Veterans Taskforce 12/5- student veterans are not utilizing resources and have reported via a survey conduct by Mandy Dykman that Veterans have trouble connecting to others (131 responses); Currently, there are 1275 veterans and dependents utilizing their benefits on campus and includes CNM.
