Argentine Foreign Minister Dante Caputo and Mexican counterpart Bernardo Sepulveda met in Buenos Aires last week to begin a series of meetings on examining possibilities of improving bilateral relations. At the welcoming ceremony on Oct. 23, Caputo said the meeting will focus on expansion of economic relations and Mexican participation in the construction of a gas pipeline, among other issues. Sepulveda arrived in Buenos Aires on Oct. 22 after meeting with Brazilian officials to discuss the eventual creation of a Latin American common market.
