What is HERN?

- HERN, or the "Health Experience Research Network" is a network using a specific rigorous methodology designed to support bringing patient experiences into changing healthcare
- Formed in the UK in 2001 as "DIPex International"
- US partnership started in 2014


How does the methodology work?

HERN's output is organized in **modules**:

- Modules are specific health topics, like "depression in young adults"
- Patients are recruited, in-person interviews are recorded (video, audio or written per request)
- Clips or transcript portions are publicly disseminated in organized format



Brief Outline:

Jamie had cold or flu-like symptoms, but no cough, early in the pandemic (2020). He developed breathlessness and general malaise. His main challenges were getting a clear diagnosis for his illness and getting some people to take his symptoms seriously.

> More about me...

Jamie is an engineer in his mid-thirties. He lives with his wife and baby. Before Covid he was relatively fit and healthy.

He went to his local Covid hub in April 2020 feeling breathless. After testing his blood oxygen levels, he was advised that he probably had Covid and to rest. His wife developed similar symptoms but quickly recovered. Jamie's breathlessness lasted for a couple of months. He developed a 'horrible' general malaise, and had recurring throat ulcers, sore glands and some dizziness which he found scary and made him anxious. Later in 2020 he developed severe headaches. His whole body ached. It felt like a cross between flu and sunstroke.

How can libraries get involved?

- "Community of practice" Knowledge and use of HERN resources
- Involvement in module creation libraries as recruitment tools
- Secondary use of data using, organizing and/or disseminating data already collected

- The HERN network is a collaborative, welcoming, multinational research partnership

- The HERN node meets regularly to share ideas, find partners and ask questions
