NECROLOGY

Isak Dahle died November 25, 1937, at the age of 54. He was an authority on Norse culture.

Junius Henderson, curator of the Museum of the University of Colorado from 1903-1933 and Professor Emeritus, died November 4, 1937, at the age of 72 years.

Professor Waldemar Jochelson, anthropologist of the Carnegie Institute, died at the age of 82 on December 2, 1937. He was a member of the Jessup North Pacific Expedition during 1901-2.

Dr. Alphonse Mingana, 55-year-old orientalist, died at Birmingham, England, December 5, 1937.

James King Steele, authority on Asiatic art and culture, died at Reno, Nevada, December 26, 1937. His age was 60.

Carlos Vierra, painter of archaeological murals in San Diego and Santa Fe, died in December, 1937.
