WHEREAS, the suggested plans from the UNM Provost for student success include increasing tenure-track faculty as well as staff but allocate no funds for new assistantships for graduate and professional students

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the GPSA Council endorses the resolution drafted and submitted by Graduate Employees Together (GET) that as part of the 2012-2013 academic year and budget processes that graduate and professional student funding lines should be adjusted at a commensurate rate to the projected enrollment increase; and
