Leamy, 3 miles above mouth of Guadalupe cr.

1410 - A 90 W 77 - clearing from steamer.

1420 2 BT, 7-8 inches TL, are active near the tail of the "red-rock pool" above the reef where Rhinichthys & Pantosteus spawned. Feeding, mostly on surface, occasionally taking off after sucker fry along margins of P.

Pantosteus feeding ^{over ground} at the head of the big ruffle. Two Ceila are following a Pantosteus about, apparently glancing. ~~Other Pantosteus~~

This was repeatedly observed the other day. Other Pantosteus are feeding over the silt bottom of the P.

1445 At least two pairs of Pantosteus and Ceila going about: Pant. 5 in. - Ceila 4 in.; Pant. 4 1/2 in., Ceila 3 in.

1450 1 Pant., 6 in., with four Ceilas following it about.

1505 Rhinichthys. A few on redd but not overly active in spawning.

4-5 Ceila ^{sometimes} present on the redd with Rhinichthys, one is fairly constantly present.
