Rhinichthys actively spawning. Several  
Cila on redd, all but one left at my  
approach.

1600-1630.

Approximately 150 R.T. and several  
BT<sup>to</sup> about 9-10 miles long were concentrated in  
a shallow spring hole near shore. Trickle  
of water 57°F, main stream 78°, position of  
trout about 74. (Temp. varied as one approached  
or receded from trickle. 74° is best approximation  
of temp where main mass, including largest  
browns were).
