## THE LEGISLATURE.

### The Education Committee Don't Like Hinkle's School Bill.

#### A VETO FROM THE GOVERNOR.

##### THE COUNCIL.

The first matter for consideration was C. B. No. 3, providing that justices of the peace, etc., shall be elected at the general election instead of in January. This bill was passed by a vote of 11 to 4.

C. J. R. No. 2, providing for the purchase of land for the purpose of establishing a school for the deaf and dumb. This bill was passed by a vote of 11 to 4.

Mr. Larragute moved that the governor be requested to return H. J. R. No. 5, the employment of compensation measure, for the purpose of correcting some clerical errors.

Mr. Hinkle stated that there was a vacancy in the clerkship of the committee on education and moved that W. S. Barker, of Albuquerque, the efficient and responsible of the Albuquerque Citizens and Las Vegas, be elected to the vacancy. The resolution was carried, with Mr. Hinkle's negative vote. A few minutes later Mr. Hinkle secured the floor and stated that he was opposed to any increase in the amount of the salary of the clerk of the committee. Mr. Barker followed on the same line. Messrs. Curry and Hinkle explained that this was not a salary increase, but that it had by its original intention been intended to be a salary increase. The committee remained divided, and that there were 26 council members in attendance and only twenty-five had been named. Mr. Barker's tenure of office was, therefore, allowed to remain unshaken.

Another resolution, calling for a number of expressions on the subject of economy, was introduced by Mr. Hinkle, at the request of the officers of the Territorial Bar association, providing that the presiding officer of each house detail a clerk to assist in the work of the committee. ### The New Officers—A First-Class Capital Building.

#### MANY INTERESTING ITEMS.

SOCIETY, N. M., Jan. 25. The new public officers of the county of Socorro made a lively scene in and around the court house today.

The new board of commissioners were in session, receiving papers and official documents from the retiring board of commissioners. Sheriff Leopold Contreras, with his excellent ex-Deputy Capt. Sam Meek, was completing the turning over of his office to Sheriff-elect Bursum, and setting with the county. Norton P. Kelson, elected assessor, and Eladio Baca, elected probate clerk, while Treasurer-elect E. L. Browne, were also busy.

The new commissioners are C. T. Brown, Clement Hightower and Anastasio Trujillo, and are so popular in their county that the people elected them by a large majority. At the session today, Hon. E. V. Chavez, ex-Probate clerk, appeared before the board while they were canvassing the vote for justice of the peace and constables, and in consequence, reports say, contents are looked for from democratic sides.

Eladio Baca, the probate clerk, is really an Albuquerque boy, but he was prospered immensely in Socorro. He retains J. F. Towle as his chief deputy, while Miss Mary L. Woodworth, a young lady well known in the Leekhart household of this city, will also occupy the clerk's office.

Sheriff-elect Bursum did not present today, but his chief deputies, M. O. Burdick and A. B. Baca are, and they are watching the duties enunciated upon them in a proper manner.

There is not now much business in the assessor's office, and for the time being, assessor-elect Kelson will do the work alone. However, Robert Collins will receive the appointment of deputy when the proper time arrives; he can now be found at the assessor's office.

Baca, a brother of Eladio Baca, was appointed county jailer by Sheriff Bursum. Mr. Baca was the town marshal of Socorro, and resigned to accept the jailer ship. R. W. Moore, ex-town marshal, was named to fill the vacancy, and on Monday night the council confirmed the appointment of Mr. Moore. Both are excellent officers.

LADY'S PYTHIAN LODGE. The mothers, wives and sisters of the Socorro Pythians have organized Socorro Temple, No. 2, of the Rathbone Sisters, and Monday evening formally organized by installing the following named as officers: Mrs. K.
