

## **LibKey Suite - Access Full Text Faster**

HSLIC has subscribed to the LibKey Suite through Third Iron. This is a suite of products designed to connect users easily and quickly to the full text of articles. It includes the following products:

<u>DOI/PMID Search</u> - will search for any DOI or PMID using your browser. To get started select University of New Mexico Health Sciences Library & Informatics Center as the organization.

LibKey Link - a discovery accelerator that connects users directly with the full text of an article. Simply click "View PDF" in Discovery or the "Find@UNM" button in EBSCO Databases and Pubmed. The "Find@UNM" button will direct users to the LibKey Landing Page where the PDF can then be downloaded.

<u>BrowZine</u> - a visual representation of HSLIC's ejournal subscriptions with the option to personalize bookshelves with favorite ejournals and save articles to a collection.

<u>Nomad Browser Extension</u> - a browser extension that links HSLIC users to the full text of articles when searching websites like PubMed and Wikipedia.
