UNM Student Success Center



UNM Student Success Center ensures that all students have the opportunity and resources to succeed by providing information to students identifying and implementing academic success programs that support progress toward graduation and enrich the student experience.

Office of University Advisement

OUA is responsible for maintaining an active discussion on advising policies, advising procedures, and training for both professional and faculty advising.

Dual Enrollment

Dual Credit/Concurrent Enrollment is a program designed to provide high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to earn college credit while still enrolled in high school by taking University courses normally not offered at the high school.

LoboAchieve

LoboAchieve facilitates meaningful contact between students, advisors, instructors, and tutors. The system encourages students to engage more deeply in their academic lives by connecting them to the people and resources in place to help them succeed.

Advisor Training

All academic advisors are required to complete specific training delivered and coordinated by OUA. All undergraduate advisors on main campus, north campus, and the branches are required to complete an annual advisor competency exam with a 90% or higher to maintain their advisor status.

Transition Advisement

Transition advisement provides support for students that are in need of changing their current major. By exploring their academic interests and major options students determine an appropriate major that aligns with future goals, while integrating their earned credit with their new program of study.

Graduation Project

Grad Project helps students who left UNM in good standing, with more than 98 earned credit hours, return and complete their degree. Grad project gives timely student support, and is a 'home-base' for returning students.

Graduation Express

Graduation Express provides students exceptional support through increased awareness of available resources.

Success Coaching

We work with students to clarify academic, personal, and professional goals. We then partner with students to develop a step-by-step strategy to foster an excellent college experience that eventually leads to graduation and the life of their dreams.

LoboReading

The Lobo Reading Experience was created as a common academic

reading program at the University of New Mexico (UNM). The program was created to offer a common reading experience that fosters a sense of community while promoting reading as an entire campus and a city wide effort that promotes literacy.

Casas Del Rio

The Student Success Center located at Casas del Rio Residence Hall is a full service academic center open to all UNM students. The center is equipped with a computer lab, study and meeting rooms, walk-in success coaching, and tutoring. Workshops, programs and events are all geared toward student success.
