Minutes of Special Session of Board of County Commissioners of Valencia County, Setting as a Board of Equalization at Los Lunas, New Mexico, on June 5th, 1916.

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session June 5th, 1916. The following persons were present:

Eugene Kempenich, Chairman; Fermín Marquez and Perfecto Gabaldon, Members of the Board; J. M. Luna, Clerk; Diego Aragon Assessor, and Ruperto Jaramillo, Sheriff.

DISPLAYS FOR THE COMING STATE FAIR.

Albuquerque, N. M., July 19.—Competition for the big cash prizes for the best county displays at the coming state fair promises to be the keenest on record, according to reports coming in to the fair headquarters. Last year only about six of the counties were actively contesting for the three cash prizes which totaled \$1800. Roosevelt county surprised the state by winning first money, \$1,000, and Eddy county was second. San Juan county's third place was hotly contested by San Miguel, Doña Ana and Santa Fe counties.

About two thirds of the counties now have made their appropriations for the county displays at this year's fair. These include all of last year's money winners and several which did not even get into the blue ribbon class but which were encouraged to make the efforts this year by the large publicity and other direct benefits enjoyed by the money winners. Requests for space allotments and details as to space at the disposal of the fair commission are pouring in, and in a number of the counties committees and experts are actively at work assembling or arranging for the displays. Both Roosevelt and Eddy County will be actively in the race for the prize money again this year. There is sharp rivalry between the two counties and both will make extraordinary efforts. Their competition, however, will be with a much larger field this year. Appropriations of \$1,000 or more have been made by ten counties and several have appropriated from \$500 to \$750. Each one proposes to win the big first cash prize.

As was the case last year absolute fairness will prevail in allowing exhibit space in the display halls. The agricultural display halls this year will be square and will not only avoid much of the space waste suffered by the shape of last year's inclosure but also will give exhibitors a much better opportunity for effective displays.

There is no longer any doubt every one of New Mexico's twenty-six counties will be represented this year with official displays. Arrangements are being made for about double the display space used last year.
