SIMPLE METHOD OF APPLYING ROAD OIL.

Celander W. H. McKieroy of Aniston, Ala. has treated a block of road on which his residence is situated with road oil, using a simple and original method. The oil used was road oil containing 25 per cent of asphalt. He had the bottom of a two gallon bucket perforated with nails. With this a man sprinkled the block in half a day. The cost for material and labor was \$3 per lot of seventy foot frontage.
