According to the Nov. 20 edition of the WASHINGTON POST, a group of contra military leaders has entered its second week of training somewhere in the United States. Citing Administration sources, the POST said the contingent of some 70 individuals will undergo six weeks of training. The training locale could be a military installation, or one of several sites controlled by the CIA. The training is part of the military aid package approved by Congress last October.
