Served the Rio la Junta between Mellans and Palisarpis creeks. The stream is low and clear in spite of recent rains. The weather has been threatening all day. Times are approximate only. Served 3:30-4:30 P.M. ~~to~~ ST. A. 57 W 46 F. 4:30 P.M. Weighed and measured fish from 5:45-.
