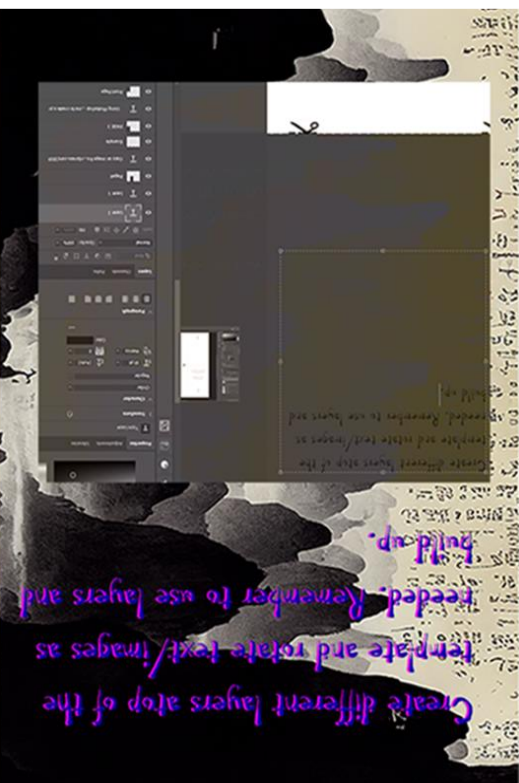

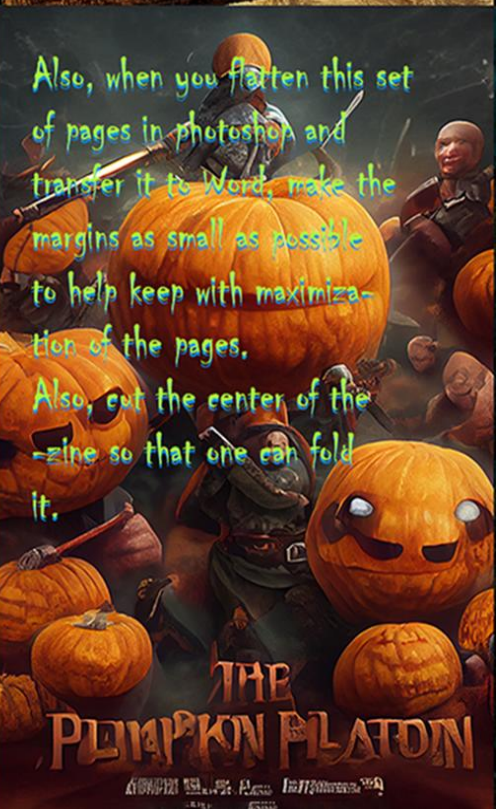
Insert random art as backgrounds

MidJourney, by the way, thankya



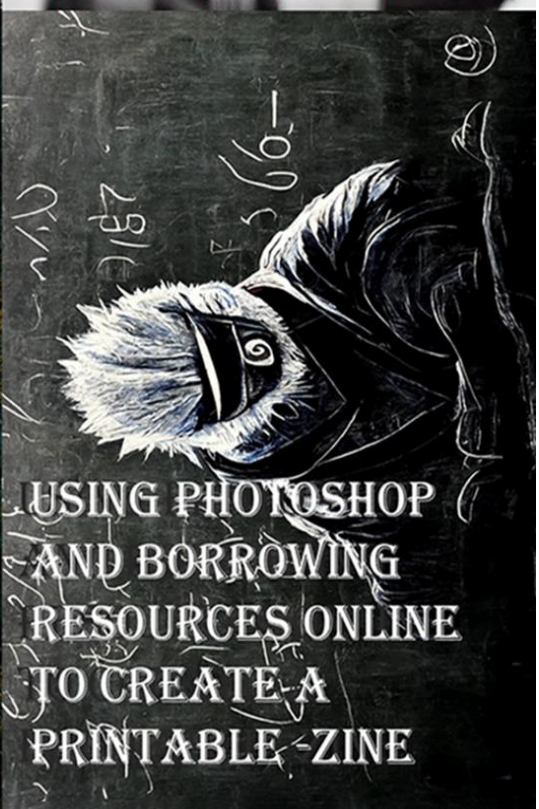
Create different layers atop of the
