Observed the feeding habitas of the three species which occur here. Rhinichthys gleans here and there, mostly overgravel. It was often observed to force its snout into the gravel with an effort. Gila picks rather carefully over various types of bottom. Pantosteus works over the material on the boulders.

Rhinichthys was ripe.
