The tributary of the Mora that enters at Holman was examined at intervals. So was the Mora between Holman and ~~WIXWELAWK~~ Cleveland. All were barren. Mora probably all diverted for irrigation in this stretch.

Fish the Mora at Mora.

Salmo trutta

fc In pools. One, $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches, taken from deep hole near entrance of riffle, released.

Catostomus commersonni suckleyi

fc In quiet pool.

Campostoma anomalum

fc Small ones in shallow riffles; large ones in deeper rocky hole. 1 adult male with pearl organs and high color in riffle.

Rhinichthys cataractae maxillosus

C in pools and riffles. Ripe, one female and several males. Probably beginning to spawn as congregations of ripe adults were met in the riffles.
