## Salmo trutta

fc In pools. One, 14 inches, taken from deep hole near entrance of riffle, released.

## Catostomus commersonni suckleyi

fc In quiet pool.

## Campostoma anomalum

fc Small ones in shallow riffles; large ones in deeper rocky hole. I adult male with pearl organs and high color in riffle.

## Rhinichthys cataractae maxillosus

C in pools and riffles. Ripe, one female and several males. Probably beginning to spawn as congregations of ripe adults were met in the riffles.
