In recognition of her outstanding contributions to the UNM Health Sciences Center (HSC), Sally Bowler-Hill, MA, PMP, has been named one of this year's recipients of the HSC Administration Staff Awards.

Winners are presented with a certificate along with a \$1,000 prize.
